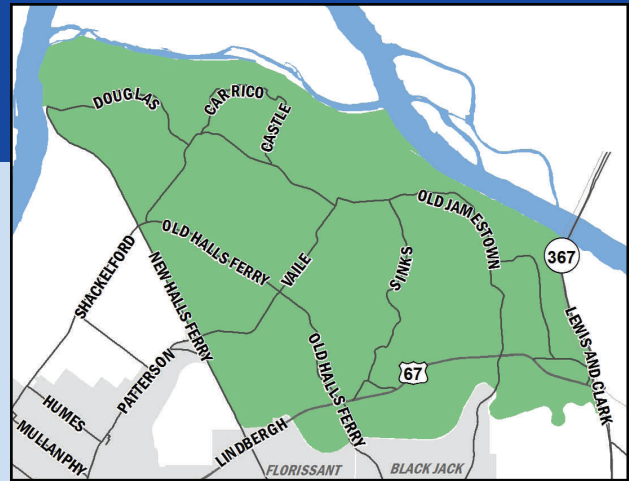


OLD JAMESTOWN

OVERVIEW

- Old Jamestown is an unincorporated community located in far north St. Louis County, Missouri, near the Missouri River.
- Old Jamestown is served by the Hazelwood and Ferguson-Florissant School Districts, the 1st St. Louis County Police Precinct and the Black Jack Fire Protection District.
- Nearby attractions include the Pelican Island State Park and Sioux Passage County Park.
- Old Jamestown was designated as a CDP by the U.S. Census Bureau in 2010.

Population

The population of Old Jamestown was 19,184 in 2010.

Sex and age

Old Jamestown is home to a high number of “baby boomers”—34.9% of the population is between the ages of 45 and 65. There are more females than males in Old Jamestown, 52.5% to 47.5% respectively.

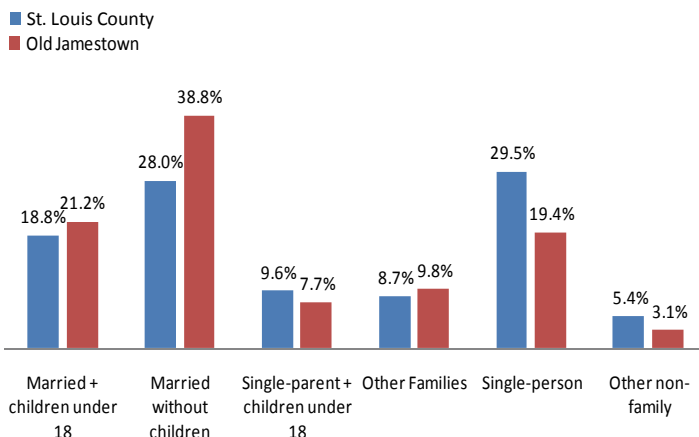
Race and ethnicity

African-Americans make up 53.7% of the Old Jamestown population and whites make up 41.9%.

Household

The most common household type in Old Jamestown is married couples without children under 18 (38.8%). Old Jamestown has a smaller proportion of single-person households (19.4%) than St. Louis County (29.5%).

Occupancy

Nearly 95% of the housing units in Old Jamestown are occupied, compared to 92.4% in St. Louis County.

Tenure

Of the 7,088 occupied housing units in Old Jamestown, 94.9% are owner-occupied, compared to 72.1% in St. Louis County.

American Community Survey vs. Decennial Census

Prior to 2010, the U.S. Census Bureau used a short-form to collect population counts and basic data and a long-form to collect more detailed data such as education, employment and income. In 2010, the long form was replaced by the American Community Survey (ACS), an annual sampling of households to measure socio-economic characteristics of the U.S. population. Because ACS data are collected continuously, they are not always comparable to data collected from the decennial census. For this reason, the sources of the data in this profile are clearly identified and comparisons between 2010 Census data and 2005-2009 ACS data are avoided.

Prepared by the St. Louis County Department of Planning using census data for Census Designated Places (CDP)—an area identified by name and having a concentration of population, housing, and commercial structures, but not within an incorporated place. A CDP is used for statistical reporting of census data.
